- The CognitiveGenesis study assessing Adventist education determined that students in Adventist schools surpass national norms on standardized tests for all subjects at all grade levels regardless of the size of the school. Also, students across all levels of ability, on average, have higher achievement scores than predicted by their ability.

We teach our students that we increase in stature by making healthy choices that honor our bodies as God's temple. Using the eight monthly themes of the CREATION Kids health curriculum, we aim to help students build healthy habits for life.

- Our Food to Fuel Learning expectation, focuses on understanding how what we eat can help with cognitive function and concentration. While we recognize each family's choice on nutrition and lunches, students are encouraged to eat healthy growing foods and drink plenty of fresh water during the school day.
- Daily physical activity happens not only in recess but in our SPARK PE program. Our experience echoes the research demonstrating that plenty of exercise helps students focus
